### Transportation Planning (MPO) Coordinator

The Greater Nashville Regional Council (GNRC) is seeking an experienced planner to manage the regional transportation planning work program for the Middle Tennessee area. Duties will include supervising the production and on-going maintenance of the Nashville Area MPO's long-range transportation plan, transportation improvement program, and unified planning work program. The position also is responsible for the coordination of planning activities with the adjacent Clarksville Urbanized Area MPO and Middle Tennessee Rural Planning Organization.

The ideal candidate will possess a strong background in transportation planning principles and practices for all modes of transportation including roadway, bicycle and pedestrian, and transit and be familiar with the state of practice for intelligent transportation systems, traffic management and operations, and land use and travel demand forecasting. The Nashville Area MPO is nationally recognized for its efforts to incorporate public health, creative placemaking, social equity, and resiliency into the planning process and we be seeking a candidate with experience in these areas.

A Master's degree in Community and Regional Planning or related field is required, along with at least two years of experience. A Bachelor's degree and five years of professional experience in transportation planning may be substituted for the Master's degree. Supervisory experience is preferred. Foreign degrees and credentials will be considered.

On October 1, 2017, the GNRC became responsible for the staffing and administrative functions of the Nashville Area MPO, a responsibility previously held by the Metropolitan Planning Commission (MPC) of Nashville-Davidson County. The integration of the MPO program into GNRC seeks to streamline and improve regional coordination among local governments across Middle Tennessee, align infrastructure planning with economic development initiatives, and bring Middle Tennessee in line with the state of practice in peer regions across the nation.
