### TDOT's Three-Year Work Program Regional Priorities

#### Background

Each year, TDOT requests local communities work with their MPO to develop a list of regional transportation priorities as part of the Department's process to develop the three-year work program that will be presented to the Tennessee General Assembly for funding as part of the state's budget.

This document presents priorities from the seven-county area of the Nashville Area MPO for consideration by the executive board. Upon endorsement, the list will be sent to TDOT.

#### Regional Priorities

##### Continued state participation in matching grants from the Federal Transit Administration

Historically, the state has provided half of the required match for FTA Sections 5303 and 5307 grants, among others.

##### Continued state funding for transit operating assistance for regional public transit agencies

Historically, that state has partnered with local governments to provide non-federal operating funds to transit agencies. In our region, those funds assist the Regional Transportation Authority, Nashville MTA, Franklin Transit Authority, the Murfreesboro Rover, and Mid-Cumberland Human Resource Agency in delivering service to a growing customer base.

##### Continued commitment of state funds and state-managed federal funds identified in the MPO's current Transportation Improvement Program

The MPO requests continued support for state revenues already identified in the current regional work program. The MPO's work program is available online at [TIP.NashvilleMPO.org](http://TIP.NashvilleMPO.org).

##### Funding for major projects in the MPO's plan that are ready for construction

TDOT presented the following priority projects that are or will be ready for construction during the FYs 2018-20 work program. The MPO staff has rank ordered the list of projects according to the corresponding rank order in the Regional Transportation Plan.

##### **1. SR-112 (Clarksville Hwy) Reconstruction**
